## Declaration:

- I understand that if any of our approved dogs become deceased, I/we will not be able to register/purchase another dog without prior permission from Council, and that approval will be revoked if the said dog proves to be a nuisance.
- I understand that the premises permit tag fee is non-refundable, and this fee does not guarantee permit approval.
- I am aware that the number of dogs kept at the above stated property cannot exceed the allowable number of dogs on a property of this size as stated in Council's Local Laws.
- I recognise that failure to comply with the Council's Local Laws and any relevant provisions of the Animal Management (Cats and Dogs) Act 2008, may result in Council taking enforcement action against myself.
- I have adequate enclosure to keep my dog in, to prevent it from wandering or escaping from my property.
- I acknowledge that my dog must always be under effective control and any waste produced by my dog/s will be disposed of appropriately if in a public place.
- I will ensure my dog/s will wear their specific registration tag at all times.
- I understand that Council's dog registration tags are Lifelong tags and are not replaced each year, the annual registration fees are still applicable however the same registration number will be used for the life of the dog.
- I acknowledge that if my dog/s lifetime registration tag becomes lost or damaged a replacement tag (with a different number) can be purchased at Council's Administration Office in St George, or by calling Council on 420 8888)
- I understand that the premises tag permit is a one-off fee and is not due each year. If I no longer require the premises permit tag, I will notify Council of the circumstances as to why, as soon as practicably possible.

## Further Information:

### Premises Tag Permit

Council's Subordinate Local Law 1.5 (Keeping of Animals) restricts residents from owning more than 2 dogs per property. If you want to own a third dog, you will have to apply for a permit. The Premises Tag Permit is a one-off fee of \$120.00. an additional dog application is required if more than 2 dogs are requested to be registered on a parcel of land. The fee does not imply approval and is subject to assessment. If approved, standard registration fees apply.

### Annual Dog Registration Fees

All dogs over three months old must be registered.

\$90 Dog – Entire  
\$45 Dog – Desexed

#### Discounts

50% for payment during the discount period in July  
50% for pensioner (additional to early payment)

### Microchipping Requirements

Queensland legislation requires all dogs and cats born after 1 July 2009 to be microchipped by three months of age.

All dogs and cats given away or sold must be microchipped at point of sale or transfer to new owner.

If you have purchased or have been given a dog or cat, it is your responsibility to ensure it is microchipped.

### Lost and Found Animals

Council's Animal Shelter is open by appointment only, please contact Council on 4620 8888 to make an appointment.

When an animal is impounded at the Shelter, Council makes every reasonable effort to contact the registered owner and the secondary contact, to collect the animal. All dogs over three months old must be registered with Council. Ensuring your dog is microchipped and wearing its Council registration tag is the easiest way to ensure you are reunited with your dog as quickly as possible.

When collecting an animal from the Shelter, release fees will be charged. If you have a lost pet, check Council's website, Facebook page or contact Council on 4620 8888 to report it missing.

Alternatively, if you have found a pet, please report it to Council immediately so that the animal has the best chance of being reunited with its owner.
